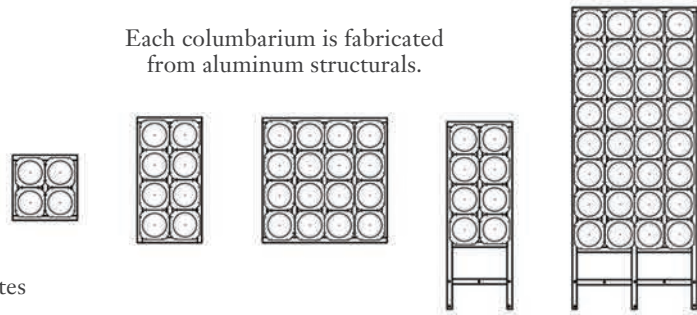


**Armento's Modular Concept**

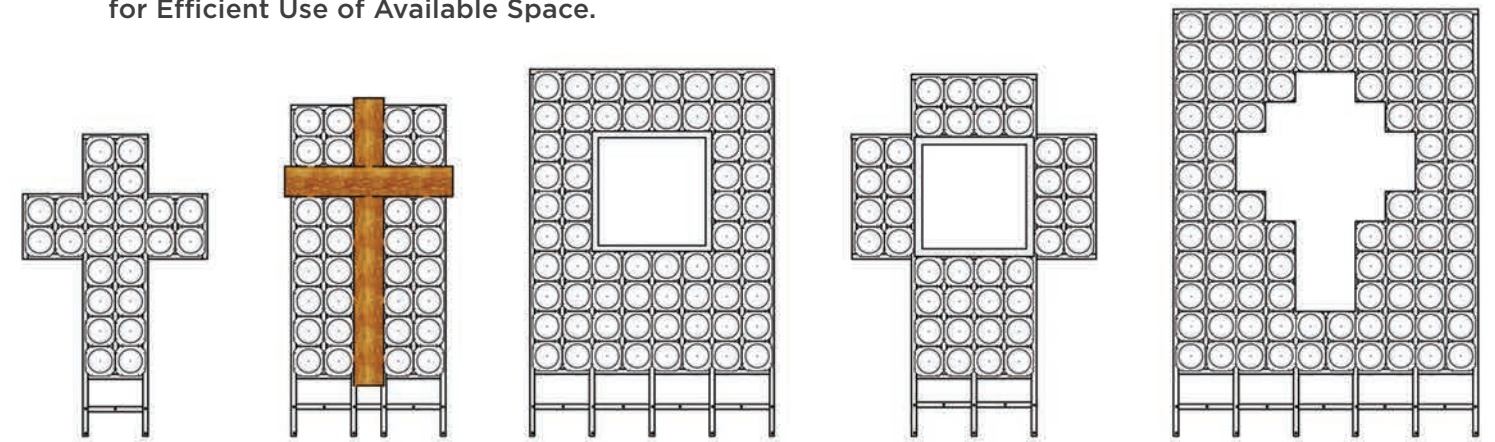
Each columbarium is fabricated from aluminum structurals.



The columbarium can be furnished with or without a base and base height can be modified to accommodate available space.

The four-niche unit forms the basis for all configurations.

**Flexibility, Creativity & Unique Design Solutions for Efficient Use of Available Space.**

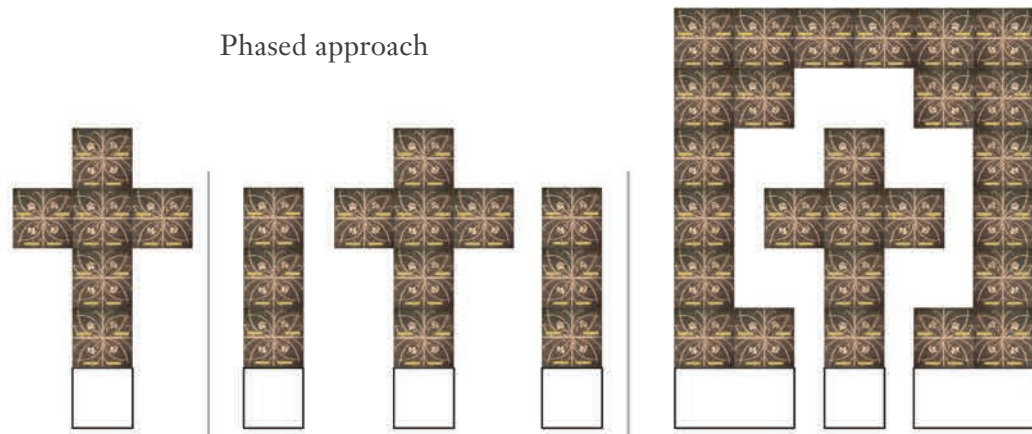


Framing is full length for structural integrity and support.

All units are furnished with a powder coated finish for added protection.

Columbarium niches and framework are shipped fully assembled and ready for easy installation.

**With proper preplanning, an Armento Columbarium can be expanded to satisfy future needs.**



Started with Cross, 24 niches.

Later added side columns, 12 niches each.

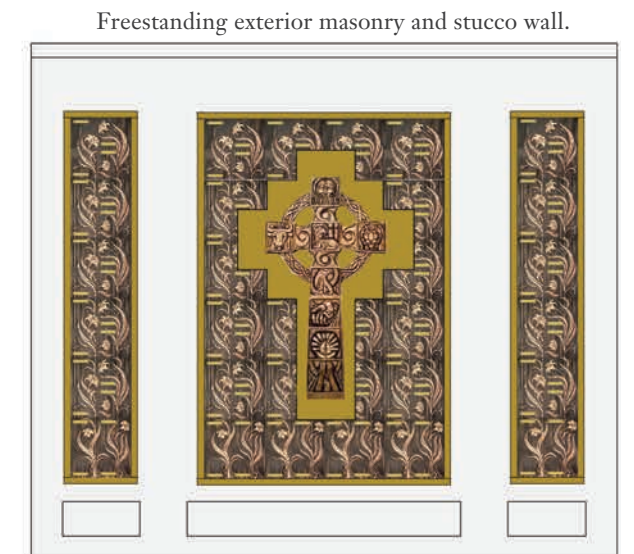
Completed with the addition of 60 niches; 108 niches total.



Started with 2 columns, 20 niches each.

Later added a third column of 20 niches.

Completed with the addition of 40 niches; 100 niches total.



First phase central unit, 60 niches. Side columns added later. 100 niches total.

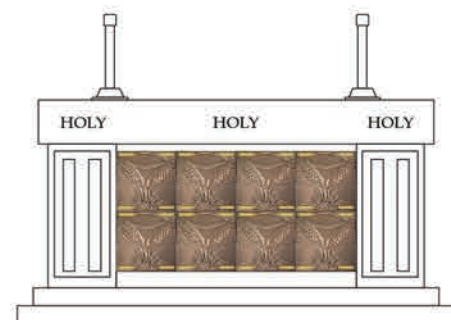
**Collaborations are encouraged and often result in creative and novel solutions.**



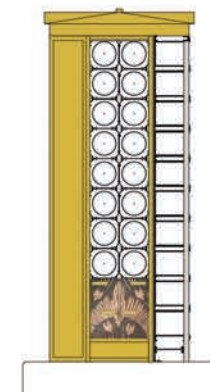
Use of individual 4 niche modules to frame a cross.
